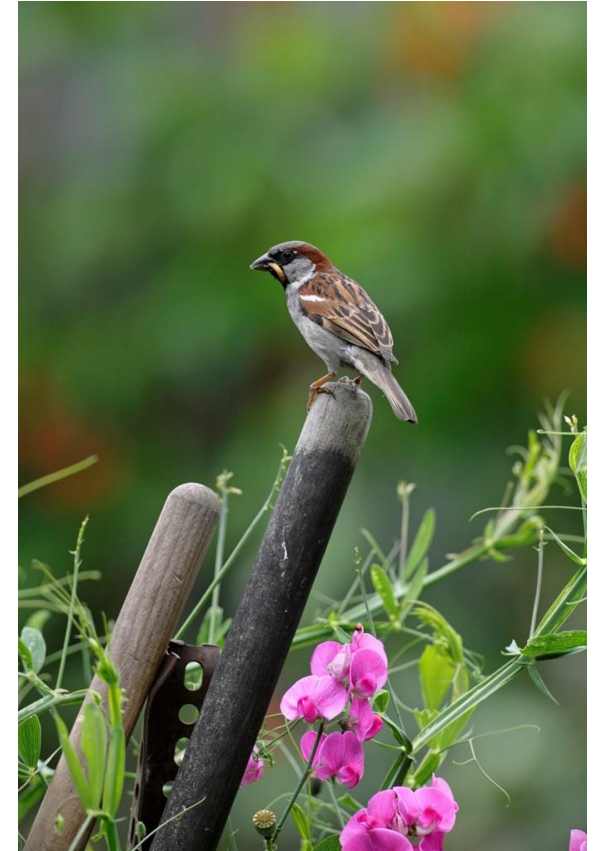

## Information for entrants

- No wildlife or habitats should be harmed, put at risk, or unduly disturbed in the process of taking photographs. Further guidance is available at: <http://www.rps.org/~media/Files/Learning/Downloads/Code%20of%20Practice%20Rebranded.ashx>
- The detail of the photograph should not be altered, e.g. removing an insect from a bird's beak. That also means no artistic or creative effects or filters applied. However basic sharpening, colour correction and cropping is permitted.
- Entrants under 18 must have teacher, parental or legal guardian consent prior to entering the competition.
- Entries must be submitted by 31 October 2017. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Entries may be on public view on the BH Sparrows Website or other social media.
- The judge's decision on all matters affecting this competition is final and legally binding. No correspondence regarding the results will be entered into.
- The results, including winner's names, will be published on the BH Sparrows website and other social media. Winners and some runners-up will have their pictures printed and featured in an exhibition at the Booth Museum in Brighton.
- Prizes will be presented or delivered within 28 days of the closing date. There is no cash alternative to the competition prizes. Any winner who has not responded to notification within 21 days will forfeit their prize; a replacement winner will be selected from other entrants.

- Include the consent form; a scanned copy is fine, or just cut and paste the details into your email.
- Colour images only.
- Images in JPEG format please.
- Minimum image resolution 3,600 pixels along the longest edge (or 30 cm at 300dpi).
- Saved at highest quality possible, minimal file compression.
