A two-hour workshop aimed at upper KS2 and particularly suitable for Year 6. We start with lively discussion of the environmental and ethical issues involved in producing the clothes we wear, and what we can all do to make our choices more responsible. Pupils then rework old t-shirts into new items, learning practical sewing skills while using their creativity.

We'll bring all materials for the workshop; all we need the school to provide is a access to a classroom whiteboard and scissors for the children to use during the upcycling activity.
